


## **PROPOSED COLORS**

## 35 West 11th Street FACADE RENOVATION

The stucco finish will be scraped and repaired as needed. The proposed new color treatment for the façade is shown and specified hereon.


The existing casement windows at the parlor level are deteriorated and must be replaced. Double hung units are proposed as the new window type. The façade/entry has been altered from its original condition to the point that the casements do not relate to the overall presentation of the house. Given that the rest of the units are double hung, the substitution at the parlor level will be more harmonious.


The smaller double hung unit at the Parlor/First Floor level and the two double hung units at the basement shall be replaced with metal units replicating the existing.

The downspout shall be repaired or replaced as necessary and painted the same color as the front wall. The air conditioner grilles shall be replaced and painted the same color as the front wall.


