



VID OPPOSES KING KONG BUILDING

With a unanimous vote at its July meeting, the membership of Village Independent Democrats has opposed Aaron Green Companies' construction of a 22-story luxury priced "King Kong" apartment tower at the corner of Charles and Washington Streets (140 Charles Street).

Using a loophole in the zoning law as a legal justification, the proposed "King Kong" tower would be the largest building in the Village -- towering over the rest of our community and constituting a menace to the quality of life in the neighborhood.

Joining with Community Board 2 in opposition to this edifice, Village Independent Democrats is urging its City Councilmember, the Borough President, the Mayor and all city-wide elected officials to use their influence to oppose the construction.
