



**Alfonse D'Amato - One-term
Republican Incumbent**

ENVIRONMENT:

Al D'Amato wants a weaker "Superfund."

EDUCATION:

Al D'Amato opposed Senator Moynihan's plan to add 100 million dollars in student aid.

GUN CONTROL:

Al D'Amato, an ally of the National Rifle Association, opposes gun control.

NUCLEAR FREEZE:

Al D'Amato voted against it.

ABORTION:

Al D'Amato is proposing a constitutional amendment that would allow states to circumvent the decision and ban abortion.

CIVIL RIGHTS:

Al D'Amato opposed the civil rights bill of 1984.

GRAMM-RUDMAN:

Al D'Amato voted for it.

NICARAGUA:

Al D'Amato voted to fund the contras.

STAR WARS:

Al D'Amato voted full funding for it.

DEFENSE EXPENDITURES:

Al D'Amato voted for all three.

SOCIAL SECURITY AND MEDICARE:

Al D'Amato voted to raise premiums and deductibles for medicare recipients, and voted against extending Social Security to disabled senior citizens.

PACs:

Al D'Amato accepts special interest PAC money.

Ralph Nader says Mark Green has already accomplished more than most U.S. Senators.

Mario Cuomo says Mark Green will be "one of the best articulators of issues you've ever seen in a Senate race."

For the past 15 years Mark Green has been a leading progressive spokesman for both fresh ideas and Democratic ideals.

As head of Ralph Nader's Congress Watch, Mark led efforts to clean up toxic waste, deregulate and reduce airline fares, enforce occupational safety laws, and provide more than \$500 million in loans to small businesses. And it was Mark's lawsuit (Green v. U.S. Department of Commerce) that forced the public disclosure in 1980 of 1400 American companies which were cooperating with the Arab states' boycott of Israel.

Mark has written a dozen books on business and government, including his best-selling book Who Runs Congress?, which established him as a national authority on how Congress works. The late U.S. Representative Ben Rosenthal called it "the book new senators and congressmen read to learn the ropes in Washington."

Today, Mark runs The Democracy Project in New York, a leading Democratic policy group. In 1984 he served as chief speechwriter in Senator Gary Hart's presidential campaign. And last year Governor Mario Cuomo appointed Mark to his Industrial Cooperation Council.

According to The Nation magazine, "Next to Ralph Nader himself, Mark Green is probably the most industrious and successful public interest lawyer of his generation."
