SENIOR CITIZEN RENT INCREASE EXEMPTIONS:

In order to be eligible for a rent increase exemption, you must meet ALL of the following criteria:

- 1. live in a rent controlled apartment
- 2. Receive a rent increase authorized by the Office of Rent Control
- 3. Be 62 years of age or older
- 4. Not receive welfare payments
- 5. Be the head of your household
- 6. Your total annual disposable income is not more than \$5,000
- 7. Your rent, as increased, is greater than one-third of your annual income.
