It also required the Authority to continually serve and post bilingual notices of tenants’ rights.

— **RICHARD F. BRAUN:** an outstanding lawyer who has spent his career fighting for the rights of tenants, co-op owners, consumers, small businesses, senior citizens, people with disabilities and the poor, and fighting discrimination against minorities, women, and lesbians and gays.
