Paul Robeson was a genius. Foremost concert artist, renowned Shakespearean Actor - All American four letter athlete, scholar, linguist and champion of human rights. Robeson made a decision "THE ARTIST MUST ELECT TO FIGHT FOR FREEDOM OR SLAVERY, I HAVE MADE MY CHOICE". His vocal opposition to racism and injustice at a time when society would not tolerate a black man who spoke his mind, eventually destroyed his career. Like Chaplin and Wells, Robeson was a survivor, a genius whose talent, commitment and personal integrity outlived his critics and detractors. This film is dedicated to restoring the name of Paul Robeson to its rightful place in the history of America.


