

He has obtained numerous court rulings favorable to homeless families. He gained access to Welfare hotels and homeless shelters despite opposition from the operators of these facilities.

Deborah Glick: Former President of The Gay and Lesbian Independent Democrats. Ms. Glick has recently been appointed to Community Board #2. Deborah began her political activity in the late 60's. Sexism in the Left led her to Womans' Movement issues of reproductive freedom, pay equity, ERA passage, child care and rape/domestic violence. She is active in the Lesbian Liberation Committee of The Gay Activist Alliance, Now-New York, Lesbians in Government and GIID.
